Next steps:

- 1) Applicants will receive an Admission Letter and will enroll on the FY Programme through the website universitaly.it submitting a pre-enrolment request form.
- 2) The University of Parma will issue a Validation Letter once applicants have paid 15% of tuition fees and sent a copy of the money transfer receipt to foundationyear@unipr.it.
- 3) Applicants holding their Admission Letter and Validation Letter are requested to apply for a type D Visa (study purpose) at the Italian Embassy/Consulate in their home country.
- 4) If candidates don't obtain a visa for study purposes (type D), the University of Parma will refund the tuition fees paid (see point 2), except bank charges and the amount due (€300) for the online Italian language course which is compulsory for absolute beginners.
- 5) Prospective students are requested to pay 65% of tuition fee by:
 - “Early Birds”: 10 September 2022;
 - “Regular”, “Dante” and “Music programme”: 1 October 2022.
- 6) Students are requested to pay the remaining 20% of total tuition fees by:
 - “Early Birds”: 1 October 2022;
 - “Regular”, “Dante” and “Music programme”: 22 October 2022.

Students will be admitted in chronological order upon payment.
